

Australian Biathlon Athletes' Commission

Australian Biathlon is looking to set up an Athletes Commission. The role of the Athletes' Commission is to ensure the athletes point of view is considered when decisions are made regarding biathlon in Australia.

The Athletes' Commission will represent active athletes and give them a voice in decisions regarding biathlon in Australia. They will interact with ABA Operational sub-committees from the athlete's perspective on matters within the Operational Sub-Committee's TOR.

The business of the Athletes' Committee will be conducted, decisions will be made, and athletes appointed in accordance with the terms of reference of the Athletes' Commission. The TOR will be proposed by the Athletes' Committee and confirmed by the ABA Board.

Criteria for Athletes commission

- 6 members
- gender equity
- 4 who are over 18yrs
- 2 who are minimum age 16yrs
- Nominating athletes over 18yrs are preferred to have had at least one season experience training and racing at the IBU level.
- Athletes will be appointed initially for 1 year with a view to moving to a 2 year appointment, with 2 members due for appointment each year.
- If an athlete stops competing overseas, they may be asked to step down.
- Appointments to commence between March and July after the end of the IBU season and before the start of the AUS winter season.
