BA Vision


Biathlon Australia is recognised as a leading and successful snow sport in Australia





Establishing new and sustainable income streams to support development and growth of biathlon

Establish

- Snow Australia: Interschools access and mutual support with cross country and look to establish a model where Biathlon Australia becomes a disciplinary committee of Snow Australia, like Cross Country and Skimo (Nordic Division).
- Disabled Winter Sport Australia: establish and evolve para-biathlon program
- **Biathlon National Federations: Establish** and evolve training bases, including building on relationships with other NFs for camps and training + WC/IBU Cup athlete support
- Shooting Australia: Establish participation program in SA event
- NRAA + SSAA: Range officer certification pathway; licensing support and justification through Club membership; insurance, facility access and partnership.



- Develop coaches supporting biathlon participation and development programs



- Establish and implement a policy framework that assures and promotes appropriate conduct within the organisation and sport of biathlon in Australia
- On-going education and implementation of child safety policy that assures a safe environment for the participation of children within the sport of Biathlon
- Lead by example to promote a culture of respect, accountability, safety, inclusion and equality
- Establish and promote independent processes to effectively manage member complaints and/or disputes raised
- Maintain policy and governance framework that assures gender equity across the sport of biathlon


